## NOTA DE PRENSA

### CELEBRACIÓN DE LA V CONFERENCIA DE EURODEFENSE PARA JÓVENES EUROPEOS

Los días 14 al 20 de Julio de 2013, EuroDefense España en colaboración con EuroDefense Portugal, va a celebrar la *V Young European EuroDefense Conference (V YEEC 2013)*. La Academia de Infantería de Toledo acogerá esa semana a unos 80 jóvenes procedentes de los 13 países europeos que forman el grupo EuroDefense. Los participantes pertenecen a los ámbitos militar y civil, siendo cadetes de las Academias Militares y alumnos universitarios de los últimos cursos de carrera.

El objetivo de la V YEEC es el intercambio de ideas, opiniones y reflexiones en torno a la temática “La Defensa de Europa: Pasado, Presente y Futuro”, desarrolladas en un ambiente multidisciplinar especialmente enfocado al concepto de la construcción de Europa. Para ello se celebrarán distintas conferencias y mesas redondas por parte de personalidades y expertos nacionales e internacionales que expondrán su visión sobre una amplia temática que abarca las propias reflexiones sobre la historia de Europa, su evolución, la política de seguridad y defensa, la industria de la defensa, las misiones militares y la importancia de su traslado a la opinión pública, abordando así mismo de qué forma los recientes acontecimientos que suceden en países musulmanes podrían afectar a la seguridad y defensa europeas.

Entre las actividades complementarias a desarrollar en esa semana, se encuentran distintas visitas tanto de carácter cultural como académico. De este modo estos jóvenes participantes tendrán la oportunidad de conocer la Base Aérea de Torrejón, la Unidad Militar de Emergencias y las instalaciones de EADS en Getafe. Desde el ámbito cultural, la ciudad de Toledo, declarada por la UNESCO Patrimonio de la Humanidad, ofrece el mejor marco arquitectónico y dentro de ella, la visita al Museo de Ejército permitirá a los participantes hacer un recorrido histórico que complementará su conocimiento de la historia de la defensa en España a lo largo de los siglos.

Los miembros de EuroDefense España, con su Presidente Don Arturo Fernández Alvarez, estarán presentes en esta conferencia a lo largo de la semana, especialmente durante las ceremonias de apertura y clausura que contarán con la asistencia y participación de distintas autoridades militares y civiles a las que dará la bienvenida el General Director de la Academia de Infantería, Don Fernando Aznar Ladrón de Guevara, bajo cuya hospitalidad se desarrollarán estas jornadas.

### V YOUNG EUROPEAN EURODEFENSE CONFERENCE

On July 14<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup>, 2013 EuroDefense España in collaboration with EuroDefense Portugal, will hold the V Young European EuroDefense Conference (V YEEC, 2013) under the hospitality of the Toledo Infantry Academy. The Conference will be attended by about 80 young people from the 13 European countries that make up the EuroDefense group. These participants are cadets at Military Academies and University students in their last academic years.

The purpose of the V YEEC is the exchange of ideas, opinions and reflections about "The Defence of Europe: Past, Present and Future" in the context of a multidisciplinary environment. The conference includes several lectures and roundtables, being the speakers national and international experts and authorities that will present their views on a broad scope of topics, such as the evolution of Europe, its security policy and defence industry; military missions and the importance of their communication to the public. They will also address issues related to recent events in Muslim countries that might directly affect European security and defense.

Complementary academic activities have been scheduled for this week with visits to Torrejón Air Base, Military Emergency Unit and EADS facilities in Getafe. From the cultural point of view the city of Toledo, declared by the UNESCO as Heritage of Mankind, offers the best architectural framework. A tour to the Army Museum will allow these young participants to know a part of the history of the Spanish Army throughout the centuries.

EuroDefense España members, together with its President Mr. Arturo Fernández Alvarez will attend this conference, especially the opening and closing ceremonies where it is expected the attendance and participation of several military and civilian authorities that will be welcome by General Fernando Aznar Ladrón de Guevara, Director of the Infantry Academy.
